Sacrificial giving is trusting that God will provide all that we need and is unique for each household. We are called to respond to God's blessings in our lives.

### TREASURE: Your Gift makes a Difference

As part of your 2021 stewardship, we ask each household to make a regular financial commitment. Each donation makes a difference for our ministries and helps us fulfill the vision of St. John Paul II Parish. Each family is asked to work toward the biblical 10% tithe in the following manner:

- ◆ 5% of annual household gross income to our **GENERAL OPERATIONS**. Your 2021 commitment can be made on the back of this form.
- ◆ 4% of annual household gross income to our "*Open Wide the Doors to Christ*" **CAPITAL CAMPAIGN** or another worthy **CHARITY**. The capital campaign is a separate commitment, beyond your regular annual general operations commitment.
- ◆ 1% of annual household gross income to the annual **ARCHBISHOP'S CALL TO SHARE**.

**Tithe** is the biblical standard for giving, which is rooted in the Hebrew Scriptures, reinforced by the New Testament teaching on generosity, and exemplified in the lives of the early Christians. The word "tithe" comes from the word meaning "tenth" and is used to indicate the portion of one's gross earnings ("first fruits") that was set apart for God.

**Stewardship**, quite simply, is recognizing that everything we have and everything we are is a gift from God and being grateful and generous with those gifts.

**Saint John Paul II Catholic Church is called to open doors to Jesus Christ through authentic witness in the home, joyful hope in worship, and fruitful service to our neighbors, offering the opportunity not to have more but to be more.**
